Highway Commissioner, Lonnie shared plans to move forward with the lean to and new doors for the shop. Trustees shared all upgrades that has been done to the community center, such as new tables, painting inside and out, new sign and the utilization of the building. Cemetery report, Roger shared that Mike was letting Andy Downen mow and Matthew was helping and that all was in good shape. Scott presented \$350. for purchase of cemetery plots: (Kukac) \$150 at Old Prairie and (Larry Huff) \$200 at Walnut Grove. David made a motion to approve committee reports. New Business: Resolution of opposition for Township Consolidation into County Government was discussed. David made a motion to oppose the resolution. Tony 2<sup>nd</sup> it, motion carried.
